Empirically Based Risk Assessment with Juveniles Who Offend Sexually: Development, Validation, and Scoring of the JSORRAT - II

This 7-hour CEU seminar will focus on the JSORRAT-II, a 12-item empirically developed risk assessment tool for male juveniles who have been adjudicated for a sexual offense. Topics covered will include (1) an overview of risk assessment issues with juveniles, (2) description of the JSORRAT-II development sample (N=636) and the empirically-based processes used to develop the tool, (3) summary of research addressing the reliability and validity of the JSORRAT-II, (4) presentation of tentative risk levels and associated rates of sexual recidivism, (5) discussion of appropriate uses and limitations of the tool, (6) review and discussion of the scoring rules for the JSORRAT-II, and (7) scoring and discussion of several practice cases. This seminar should be relevant for a broad range of professionals who work with juveniles who sexually offend, including case workers, probation officers, therapists, and juvenile court/juvenile justice professionals.



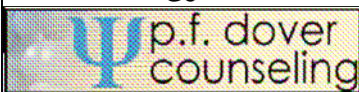
